

A few tips about program settings and use **RadarOpus update 4.1**

Change the screen resolution of your computer

The latest RadarOpus v. 4.1.12 is adapted to a wider variety of screen resolutions. If after installation of RadarOpus 4.1.12 you feel that the icons and menu text is not optimally displayed, then see the below steps:

Change the screen resolution if one of these two things exist:

- The letters of the text in Synthesis appear not sharp.
- If many icons of the toolbar do not fit on the screen.





On Windows:

Right mouse click on the desktop, and select 'Display settings'.

Then select the option 'Scale'. Then, change the setting and select one step lower, e.g.:

- Reduce from 150% to 125%
- Or reduce from 125% to 100%



Restart RadarOpus and more icons will fit on the toolbar.




On MAC:

Go to the **Apple** icon, select **Preferences**. Then select the **Screen** (Monitor), and try to increase the screen resolution.

How to change the Repertory language

You can change the language of the repertory Synthesis 2009 and the Synthesis Adonis repertory via the **World icon**. (* A second language is an option)


- Select the first language via: **Show this document in:...**
- You can also select a second language via: **Additional language:...**



How to work with two languages in Synthesis

How to change the color and font type of RadarOpus


You can select the color of the software and the font type and size via.

On Windows: **Tools, Options** (on Windows) (this is also called the **Skin**).

On MAC: you should select the **RadarOpus** menu, then **Preferences**.


You can select from several Colors/**Skins**.

Select a different **Font Type** if you like that.




How to set a favorite Repertory or Reference

It is possible to move one or more of the titles in the list of repertories and in the list of references to the top of the list. This video show how to do this.





First select one or more titles as your **favorite** titles with a Right mouse click on the titles, then select: Add this title to my favorites.



Then you need to open the **Local Options**, and the **Tab - Display**.

Select: **Display favorites at the top of the list**.



The selected title(s) will move to the top of the list. This will be for each category separately (Repertories, Families, Concepts)


Favorite Reference titles

You can also select one or more **Reference** titles as your favorites, and select the option to move them to top of each category, if you would prefer this.




How to set your Quick References

This video explains how to set your Quick References and how to differentiate the top scoring remedies in the analysis quickly.



If you **double click** on a **remedy** in the analysis or in the repertory it opens the Quick Reference Materia Medica.



The titles which should be in the list of Quick References can be selected via the local options of the list of References.




Open the **List of References**,
then open the **Local Options**,
select the **Tab - Quick Reference**.

Select one or more titles from the list, for
example: Boericke MM, Van Woensel
Keynotes etc.

Then click on: **Use selected titles**.

You can drag and drop the selected titles to
set the priority of opening when you double
click on a remedy.

(Ps: the name **Zeus-soft Keynotes** has been replaced
by the author's name **Van Woensel E**. So the
content is identical.)




Switch off password protection.


If you store patient information in RadarOpus, it is mandatory that you keep the
security on.

Only if you do not store patient information, then you can switch off the password
protection (RadarOpus also encrypts the patient database automatically).

Go via **Tools**, to **User
accounts**.




Select: **Disable password
protection**.



Working with a smaller Repertory View


(Optional feature) If you select a smaller Repertory View, there are two **View-buttons** you can select. Most users prefer to have both options On.

- Show/Hide the **rubrics** which do not have any remedies in that View.
- Show/Hide the **remedies** which are excluded in that View.



Switch off Family Remedies in Synthesis Adonis

In Synthesis Adonis includes “**Family Remedies**” in many rubrics. These indicate that such Family has an association with that rubric. If you do not want to see these Family Remedies: Open the **local options**, Select the **Tap - Remedies and authors**, then select in the field Display Families: **Do not display families**.



New Repertory Views in Synthesis Adonis-2024 and in Synthesis 2009

The Full Installer 3.2.24 and higher, contains also a **Synthesis database update**. Both for the Synthesis 2009 and the Synthesis Adonis.




In the Synthesis 2009 and Adonis the **Vithoulkas View** has been removed because it was not fully adapted anymore new versions. It was replaced by the Erik van Woensel View:

Erik van Woensel has checked all sources of additions in Synthesis, and selected about 700 authors and document sources which he finds reliable enough to consider when analysis cases.

The “**Van Woensel E.**” View is available both in the **Synthesis 2009** and in the latest **Synthesis Adonis**.

Dr Veneeth Sidhathan Repertory View




Dr Veneeth uses **this** Repertory View, which he has created himself, with 99% of his cases, and only in exceptional cases he considers a larger Repertory View. This view is only available in **Synthesis Adonis**.

Veneeth selected from about 5000 sources, those classical homeopathic sources and some of the more modern sources, which he finds most reliable to solve almost all of the cases in his busy practice in Kerala, India. Only in a small number of cases does he consider remedy additions from a less strict View.



Dr Farokh Master - Master Score

(Optional feature) With version 3.3 or higher, an analysis method from Dr Farokh Master has come available, called “**Master-Score**”.

In this video all details are explained. You need to take at least 5 symptoms, and you can apply intensity from 1 to maximum 4. Use the higher intensities 3 and 4 only sparingly.





Compare Analysis methods


(Optional feature) With this function it is possible to compare several analysis strategies side by side.



How to make a Backup of Analysis and the Patient file


It is important to make frequent backups of the stored information in RadarOpus, The most important personal information is:

- The Patient file (including the analysis)
- Individually stores analysis
- Personal repertory additions

Each time you exist RadarOpus you will be asked to make a Backup, but you can also select it from the menu bar: **Tools, Database management, Backup.**



Then in one of the next steps select a location you can easily find back on the hard drive or on a cloud drive or external disk.
