- **Dr. Alex Tournier PhD** is a founding director of the Homeopathic Research Institute. PhD in physics with a special focus on the biophysics of water and will be speaking about the Clificol data collection project.
- **Dr. Yvonne Fok MD** is a Medical Doctor Msc in epidemiology and biostatistics and Homeopathic Researcher who will be discussing the Clificol data collection project.
- **Dr. Robbert Van Haselen MD** was the Past Deputy Director of Research at the Royal London Homeopathic Hospital and Head of Research for Heel homeopathic Pharmacy, as well as the Past Editor-In Chief of 'Complementary Therapies in Medicine'. Dr. Van Haselen will be discussing how to collect high quality data.
- **Dr. Lex Rutten MD** is a medical doctor, homeopath, and independent researcher. Dr. Lex Rutten has become a global leader on homeopathic data collection. He is the author of 45 Pubmed registered scientific articles, two books on statistics and research in homeopathy and chapters in five books on homeopathy.
- **Dr. Clare Relton PhD** is a Senior Lecturer in Clinical Trials at the Institute of Population Health Sciences at Queen Mary University of London and an honorary Senior Research Fellow in Public Health at Sheffield University in the UK.
- **Dr. Philippa Fibert PhD** completed an MSc in Research Methodology in Psychology; and a PhD in public health. In her studies she conducted a consecutive comparative case series of children with ADHD; and a pilot pragmatic RCT comparing the effectiveness of treatment by homeopaths and nutritional therapists for ADHD. Dr. Fibert will discuss V-HAWK and the POD Project.
